


- Set the airflow control to the defrost ( ) position. (The A/C will turn on automatically and "Fresh" mode will be activated.)

- A. Press UNLOCK on the transmitter to disarm and unlock the driver's door. Press UNLOCK again within 4 seconds to unlock all the doors.
- B. Press LOCK on the transmitter to lock all the doors and arm the alarm. Press LOCK again within 4 seconds to hear a confirmation chirp.






- 1. Move the select switch to the right or left to activate the corresponding door mirror.
